3. Ride-on or Walking devices

Another great choice for a floor scrubber if the area you need it for is big like warehouses and various industrial locations are the ride-on or walking scrubber machinery. These machines will allow the operator to maneuver the machinery all-around corners and obstructions efficiently and easily. These kinds of floor scrubbing machinery come equipped with a 250L water tank plus another container to accumulate the filthy water. Walking devices are similar models that could be operated by someone walking behind the machine and steering the scrubber.

4. Robotic Floor Scrubber machines

A robot floor scrubber may be another choice to think about. These designs are great if you require a high specification floor scrubber to clean a large environment that has minimal obstructions. These designs have sensors installed in order to allow the machinery the ability to avoid humans, doors, walls and stairs.
